What's on the Test?

- The SAT has four sections:

65-minute **Reading** section consisting of 52 questions/tasks

35-minute Writing and Language section consisting of 44 questions/tasks

25-minute Math Test – No Calculator section consisting of 20 questions/tasks

55-minute **Math Test – Calculator** section consisting of 38 questions/tasks

Day of the Exam

- Information on procedures for entering the building will be provided a few days before the exam.
- Please be on time. There will be no accommodation for late arrivals.
- <u>No refund</u> will be provided for any reason.
- Bring several No. 2 pencils and a calculator with you.
- The exam requires approximately 4 hours. You may expect to finish between 12:30pm-1pm. All students will be dismissed from the exam at the same time. Students who are taking the SAT are not expected to attend classes on April 13th and will be dismissed from the building at the end of the exam.

After the Exam

- Students will receive an online score report following the exam at studentscores.collegeboard.org, followed by a paper report.
- Students will receive an overall test score (400-1600) as well as individual section scores, test scores, cross-test scores and subscores.
